



World's Largest LCD TV comes to Rochester

On display at technology showcase Sept. 16

(ROCHESTER, N.Y. Sept. 14) – The world's largest LCD TV with LED backlight display will be making its Rochester debut at AV Solutions' audio-video technology showcase, Wednesday, Sept. 16. The show features real-world applications of AV technology for business.
